Monument Responsibility and Liability

All monuments commissioned for placement within Escalon Cemetery District (dba Burwood Cemetery) must receive advance approval from Escalon Cemetery District management and/or Board of Directors, as well as the holder of burial rights to the garden and lot identified.

Monuments are to remain within the standards of the rules and regulations regarding "Plants, Shrubs, Headstone Dimensions, Floral and Adornment" established by Escalon Cemetery District. It is recommended that the monument provider submit design to Escalon Cemetery District for review and approval before creating any monuments. Obscene language and/or pornographic images are unacceptable.

Monument ownership is held to those individual(s) commissioning, and/or those individual(s) granting permission for placement of, designated monument(s). Additions, modifications, repair, removal and/or replacement of monuments must be made in advance with Escalon Cemetery District.

Escalon Cemetery District may place approved monuments at the designated location (Garden and Lot) within a reasonable period, and appropriate conditions, once they have been received from the monument company. Escalon Cemetery District will notify the identified point(s) of contact when placement has been completed.

Due to limited storage space and to reduce the monument exposure awaiting installation, Escalon Cemetery District reserve the right to deny delivery of any unapproved, unscheduled, and/or monuments outside of the standards established as part of "Plants, Shrubs, Headstone Dimensions, Floral and Adornment" requirements.

We will take the utmost care of monuments related to our operations. Escalon Cemetery District is not held liable for the condition of any monument, placement, storage, removal and replacement for additional burial placement(s), or adjustment related to request, expected operational needs, or due to natural conditions. Applicable fee(s) may be applied regarding monument conveyance.
